INTENT:

When teaching writing, the following process will be adopted. However, there may be some elements that the teacher omits due to having spent time on that area in previous units of work.

- Immersion and knowledge
- Grammar, Vocabulary and Spelling
- Model, Model, Model
- Feedback
- Improve and Polish
