

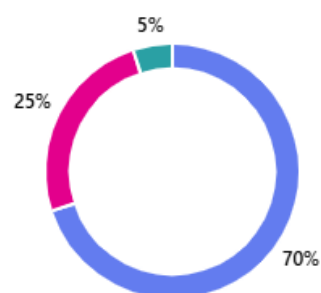

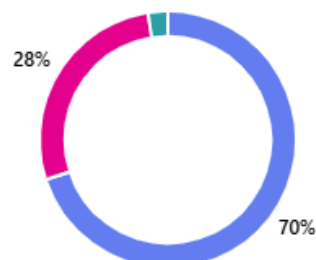
1. My child is happy at this school

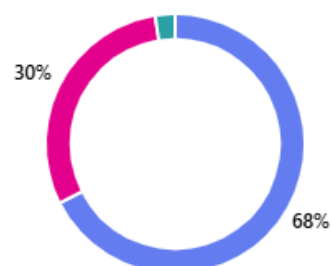
2. My child feels safe at this school

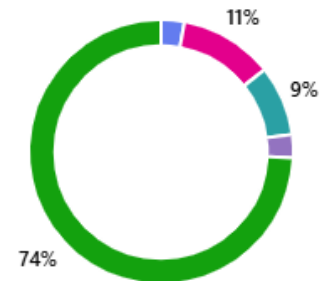
3. The school makes sure the pupils are well behaved

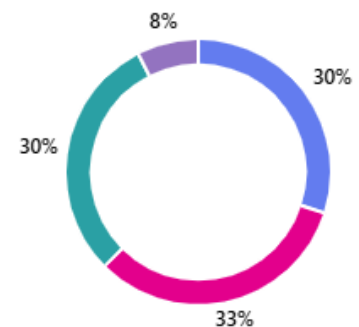
4. My child has been bullied and the school dealt with this quickly and effectively.

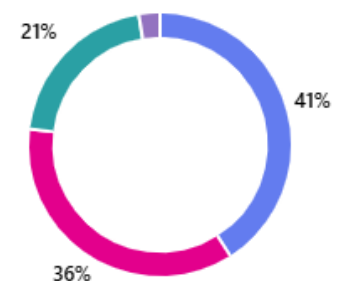
5. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year

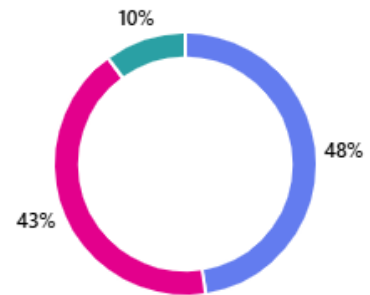
6. When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly

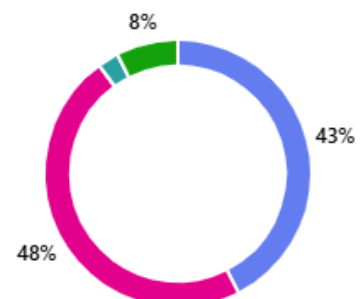
8. My child does well at this school

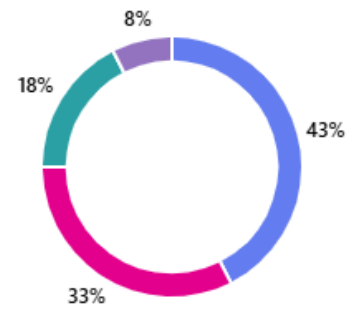
9. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school

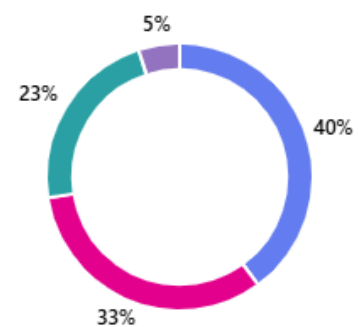
10. My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school

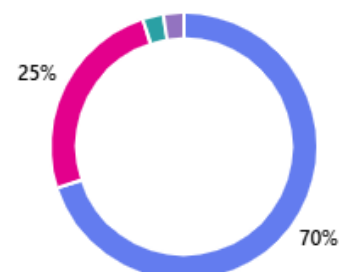
11. The school supports my child's wider personal development

Really welcoming and good sense of community. Treetops is a fantastic addition to the school. It is clear that staff are motivated and children happy.
Really good extra activities around the curriculum such as rock the school, MCSC clubs, school trips - these are the things that give the children a well rounded school day

Wide range of different activities everyday for the children to move between so they never get bored. Consistent teaching has shown great improvement in my child's reading and writing abilities. Great food options and before and after school care available now which is fantastic. Literally can't find anything to fault!

Building strong and engaged children, phonics, learning and well planned lessons and topics. The head is very clearly strong, and great for the school - many great new initiatives.

The school has massively improved since the new head teacher took over last year, I really love that the school has such an emphasis on being outdoors, the reception play area, and the garden highlight this. It also has some fantastic teachers, and a strong PTA that go above and beyond.

Foster a caring, family oriented community where parents are invited in to see learning in progress or performances etc. The school choir has been a lovely addition as has the school 'newspaper'. Allowing children to apply for leadership roles in the school is also great. I like the use of ClassDojo to share snippets of learning and photos. Happily have more of that

Friendly, approachable school environment. All staff are professional and friendly. I feel the whole school is nurturing. I feel my child is genuinely understood as an academic pupil and as their own person too. It's clear to see how hard the school works for the benefit of the children and parents and how they continue to keep moving forward.

School use different awards encouraging students to take part in the study and duty, that help to improve their communication and build up confidence,

What could we do even better?

Communication could improve, sometimes it's not been very good.

The termly booklet which is no longer issued was helpful to support choosing family outings/activities to be relevant to what is being learnt at school. Could this be issued on Dojo? A weekly newsletter, even if it's just the key dates every other week to serve as a reminder as what's coming up. The school has been transformed over the last year, it's great to see so many positive changes. Thank you

Help parents understand what is needed from them

My child would love to go on more school trips!
Communicate better, some things seem to be left to the last minute or not very clear information is provided

Strive for greater academic excellence

Accuracy of communications e.g. correct dates and times for events in school calendar

Fix the lights on the path to the reception for low light levels.

Updating the infrastructure

Longer window to drop children off which may reduce congestion on main road and improve safety. A little more communication at the beginning of the year so we know who teachers are going to be and what the children will be learning in the year ahead. More music and sport

Regular feedback to parents on how children are doing - it was only in the most recent parents evening I was told my child was in a 'target group' for reading - I wasn't aware before this.

Not sure - perfect so far!

Give more details on the forthcoming curriculum so parents can ask questions about the school day and encourage discussion. Promote themselves better for all the lovely things that go on at the school. Put more pictures/videos on the school website. Allow parents to take photos of their own child engaging in activities at school.

I think the school has made a huge turnaround from 15 months ago and I know other parents see it too

A lot of my neutrals are due to only being involved with the school for a limited time (6months) so I am yet to form opinions or have the full experience. I'd be interested to know when the next Ofsted inspection will be given the mark down the school received last year. Though not entirely unanticipated, the traffic and congestion in Amotherby is terrible, I particularly dislike the huge lorries that go through the village at peak school hours and exacerbate the issue; there may be nothing to be done about this, but if the school does feed into council plans / road planning and new routes could be established in the future I would strongly advocate for this.

We have seen positive improvements and progress over the past 18 months. Thank you for all of your hard work!
