- Curriculum matters, especially around the teaching of RE and maths – valuable feedback was shared and will be fed into future planning.

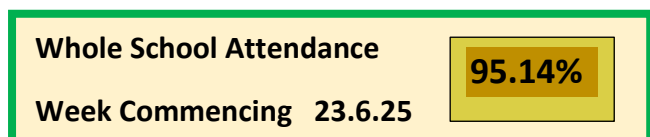
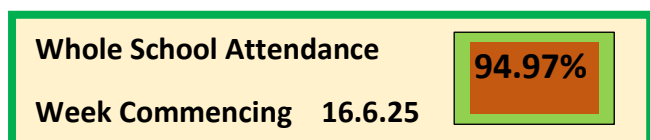
