## Admissions Policy

Amotherby Community Primary School has a wide catchment area, drawing pupils from Amotherby and 17 surrounding villages. We also have many pupils who, although not residing within our catchment area, choose Amotherby School for our warm and welcoming community, and our rural, friendly feel.

All children are allocated a full-time place in our school during the academic year in which they are 5. Children are allocated a full-time place at our school when they are 4 but do not have to take it until they are statutory required to in the term they are 5.

We are always happy to welcome visits to the school and arrangements can be made for the parents of new entrants to visit the school when they may see the working conditions and meet their child's teacher and the head teacher. The children are also invited to see the school and familiarise themselves with their teacher, classroom and routine during the term before they enter the school full-time. Details are forwarded to parents regarding these arrangements. Pupils remain until their transfer to secondary education at the age of eleven.
